COMPETITION RULES

- Each team will consist of seven players from a squad of up to twelve. Replacements during a tie will be allowed with the referee's permission.
- Teams should assemble before the end of the previous game so that you are able to start as soon as the pitch is free. In the event of a clash of colours the first named team in that tie will change shirts.
- All matches will be six minutes each way. Half time will be one minute. If scores are level in the semi-finals or final at full time, one further period of two minutes will be played until a side scores. If neither side scores during extra time, drop kicks at goal will decide the winner.
- The following 7-a-side law variations will be in operation: Ball not reaching 10 m at kickoff (unless the opposition play the ball), or ball kicked directly into touch from kickoff: free kick at centre. Penalty kick: any form of kick except a place kick from the ground.
- SRU S1 law variations will be followed. (Conversion attempts are taken no wider than the 15m line; 5 points for a try, 2 points for a conversion and 3 points for penalties and drop goals.)
- Tied teams should nominate three kickers each.
- After a toss to determine which team chooses to start, drop kicks are taken alternatively from a spot decided by the referee.
- If scores are tied after three kicks each, sudden death applies using the same order of kickers (an injured kicker may be replaced by another member of the squad).

In the group stages, a win scores two points and a draw scores one point. If two or more teams are level after playing their group matches, the positions shall be decided as follows:

- 1 The largest number of points for
- 2 The least number of points against
- 3 The result of the game between two tied teams
- 4 Drop kick competition




